34 KM. ESCORNALBOU CASTLE






34 km. Escornalbou Castle

46 KM. SERRA DE L'ARGENTERA








Variant of the Serra de l'Argentera Tour, though slightly longer and with a view of Falset, the capital of El Priorat county.












67 KM. LLABERIA






67 km. Llaberia

80 KM. SIURANA







80 km. Siurana

The legendary town of Siurana is the Mecca of fans of free climbing. But it is also a must-see for cycling tourists. The long, arduous climb is well rewarded with some impressive views. The route takes you through the Teixeta and Porrera passes, returning via the Alforja pass.



84 KM. ESCALADEI







84 km. Escaladei

94 KM. LA MUSSARA, AND ALFORJA, LA TEIXETA AND ROIG PASSES






94 km. La Mussara, and Alforja, La Teixeta and Roig Passes




132 km. Camp de Tarragona, Prades Mountains, El Montsant and El Priorat

This extraordinary cycling challenge will allow you to enjoy to the full the different landscapes of the Costa Daurada. Beginning with the plain of Camp de Tarragona, we gently climb toward the Prades Mountains to continue along the skirts of Montsant, which opens the way to El Priorat.

This route crosses the Prades Mountains from south to north. As well as its symbolic and historical importance, Poblet is also an impressive architectural site and is the largest inhabited monastic site on the continent of Europe. Poblet has been declared a UNESCO Human Heritage Site.



141 KM. RIBERA D'EBRE AND EL PRIORAT






141 km. Ribera d'Ebre and El Priorat

148 KM. PRADES MOUNTAINS AND EL MONTSANT






148 km. Prades Mountains and El Montsant







