Banks

You can rent a bath rope at a rate of € 6.00 per stay.

Pool towels are provided at a rate of € 4.00. Please do not use the towels of your room at the pool area. You can dry your pool towels on the clothes horse rack on the terrace.

Beaches

Cambrils has 9 kms of beautiful beaches. All beaches are manned by a lifeguard.

On each of Cambrils' beaches you will see a flag. The colour of the flag will let you know the water conditions at that time. There are three different flag colours:

Green flag: swimming allowed.

Yellow flag: swim with caution.

Red flag: swimming not allowed.

Cambrils Beaches from South till North (L'Arcadia beach, being closest to Mont-roig el Camp and Cap de Sant Pere beach being closest to Salou):

L'Ardiaca Beach

This beach is located slightly outside of the centre of Cambrils. There is a breakwater along its length, ensuring that the water is safer for children. It is one of Cambrils' less crowded beaches. There are outdoor showers, toilets, sun loungers and parasols to rent, pedal boats and chiringuito (a beach restaurant) selling food and drinks.

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La Llosa Beach

This beach is located slightly outside of the centre of Cambrils. There is a breakwater along its length, ensuring that the water is safer for children. It is comparable in terms of facilities to L'Ardiaca Beach, and it is about as crowded.



D' Horta Beach

D' Horta beach is one of Cambrils' smallest beaches. It is located close to the centre of Cambrils. This makes it a popular and sometimes crowded option. There are outdoor showers, toilets, sun loungers and parasols to rent and a chiringuito (a beach restaurant) selling (excellent) food and drinks.

La Riera Beach

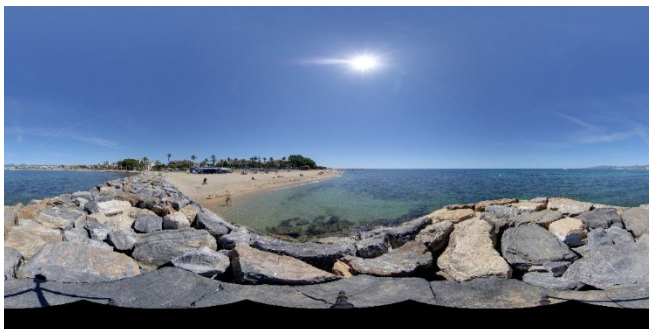
This is one of Cambrils' most central beaches. It is small and generally busy. It does not have as many facilities as some of the other beaches, but it does have showers.



Prat d'En Forés Beach in front of McDonalds

This is one of Cambrils' most popular beaches. It is also one of its larger beaches: 967 metres in length. This beach is awarded not only a "blue flag" but also a 'blue flag wave point' - meaning that it is good for surfing. It is one of the most well-serviced of Cambrils' beaches. In the water area of this beach there is a 'sea platform' - an area that you can swim out to in the sea. There are showers, toilets, sun loungers and parasols to rent, pedal boats and a small shack selling food and drinks.

El Cavet beach



This is a beach slightly further from Cambrils' town centre. It offers a sandy beach and calm water. It is one of the least crowded of Cambrils' beaches. It offers showers, toilets, canopies and sun loungers.

L'Esquirol beach

This is one of Cambrils' most picturesque beaches. It is reasonably long (895 metres) and quite crowded. It is located in a semi-urban area, away from the main port area. It provides disabled access. It has showers and a toilet, pedalos, sun loungers and parasols to hire.

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Vilafortuny beach

This is one of the Cambrils' longest beaches (1,415 metres). It is generally very crowded in summer months. It has been awarded with a “blue flag” and a “blue flag wave point” due to the generally strong waves. It offers showers, toilets, sun loungers, canopies and pedalos to rent.



Cap de Sant Pere beach

Cap de Sant Pere Beach offers a picturesque stretch of fine sand and calm water. It is located at one of the furthest points from the port area of Cambrils. However, it is close to Cambrils largest camping grounds, ensuring that it is very busy in the summer months. It offers showers, toilets, a foot wash, pedalos, canopies and sun loungers to rent.

Nudist Beach at Platja del Torn

In L'Hospitalet de l'Infant you will find Platja del Torn. An idyllic nudist beach outside the inhabited centre of L'Hospitalet, discretely hidden from view, stretching about 1700 m. Accessible from exit 38 at the A-7.

Biking and bike rental

Cambrils is a very popular biking spot.

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Golf

Located within a range of 35 km from the Mas you have the choice of 5 golf courses and 1 pitch and putt course:

Lumine- Port Aventura Golf

There are three golf courses located within the grounds of the Port Aventura theme park: North Course, Centre Course and South Course. All at 20km from the Mas.

The North Course (Lumine lakes)

This course was designed by Greg Norman. It is an 18-holes course that is a challenge. It is located within the wetlands of the region.

The North Course club house is a modern building offering a restaurant, a sauna, a driving range, a golf school, a snack bar and dressing rooms.

The Centre Course (Lumine Ruins)

This is a smaller course, 9-holes and par 34, also designed by Greg Norman. is situated on the highest point of the resort, between the North and South course.

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The South Course (Lumine Hills)



This 18-holes, par72 golf course offers views of the sea beyond a skyline of white pine trees. Of the three courses this is the one that is used by professional competitors. It is the longest of the three courses. The facilities on offer include a restaurant, a sauna, a driving range, a golf school, a snack bar and dressing rooms.

Septic Tank

The Mas is not connected to the public server. We purify wastewater through our own biological waste-water treatment plant. We pump the purified water into the olive orchard.

Other sanitary waste we collect in a septic tank. To prevent clogging, please do not throw tampons, pantliners, sanitary towels, condoms, cleansing wipes or other trash in the toilet. Thank you.

Sea Angling

In Cambrils sea angling is allowed on all the beaches in the town as from June through to September at restricted hours in the night-time, from 21:00 to 03:00, if you have the necessary permits.

The possibility of fishing goes along with the obligation to do so in a responsible manner, taking special care of the conservation of resources and the coastal ecosystem so that future generations can continue to enjoy it.

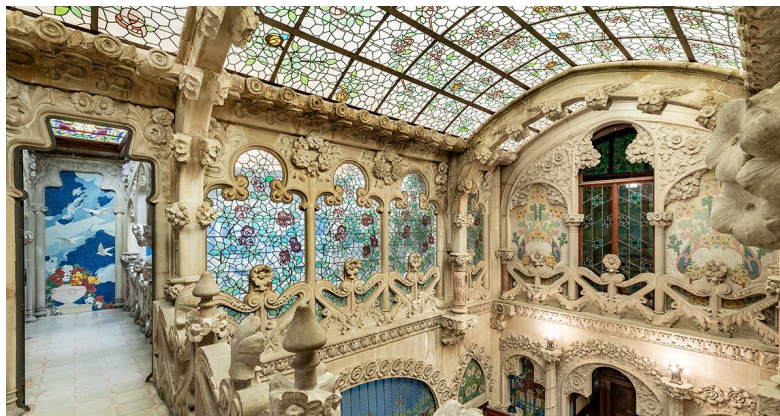

Reus, at 14 km from the Mas

Reus is a picturesque town that was once famous for the production of vermouth. Today it is a bustling town that spans 59 km² and has 100,000 inhabitants. The city is famed for its importance to the modernist movement and is full of modernistic buildings in the style of Gaudi and Lluís Domènech i Montaner.

Reus is also home to the Gaudi centre, where you can learn the history and reasoning behind his distinctive architectural style. The town centre has an impressive variety of shops and restaurants.

The **Gaudi centre**, the **Casa Navás** and the former psychiatric centre **Pere Mata**, rare definitely worth a visit.



Please bear in mind that many shops close between 13.30 and 17.00 h.

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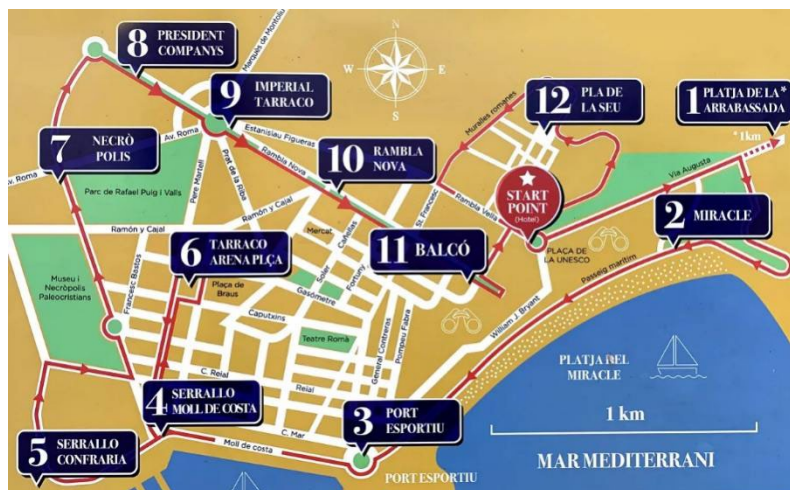

Tarragona, at 25 km from the Mas

Tarragona has some stunning Roman architecture. It has been recognised by UNESCO and is definitely worth a visit.

A nice way to visit Tarragona is by “trennet turistic” or the tourist train. The train stops at all places of interest in the centre. It is a hop on hop off train. You can always get off and then again on at next passing train. Price per day: 10 € for adults and 8 € for children under 13.

Montblanc, at 50 km from the Mas

Montblanc is a small medieval town close to Tarragona and less than 50 minutes from our B&B. It was founded in the twelfth century by King Alfonso I. It has a well-preserved medieval wall that dates back to the fourteenth century. It offers a variety of military and civil buildings. For more information check:

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Castells (Human towers)



A unique experience is attending one of the “castells”. Throughout Catalonia, there is a tradition of building 'castells', human towers. This phenomenon is so popular that there is a regional Sunday evening program entirely devoted to its competition. There are 65 officially registered 'colles' (teams) that try to make as many variants of 'castells' as possible throughout the year in the castell competition.

El Priorat and El Penedès at 40-50 minute-drive from the Mas)

The Priorat region, at a 40-minute scenic drive through the mountains, is known for its excellent DOQ Priorat and DO Montsant wines. There are several vineyards to visit and most of them also offer wine tasting. Reservation of your bodega tour and wine tasting is often required. Please note that most vineyards are closed in the weekend.



El Penedès, about 50 minutes by car from the Mas, is the region where the Spanish Cava is produced. You can visit the various cava cellars here, some of which are quite impressive, such as those of [Freixenet](#) and [Anna Codorniu](#) in Sant Sadurn d'Anoia. Guided tours are organized in different languages. You go by train through the underground cava cellars. The tours are also suitable for children. Check the websites of the bodegas for tour times and languages.

You can also visit small producers of cava and (sparkling) wines in the Penedès. It is best to check the website of the [Catalan wine tourism](#). There you will also find other activities such as cycling through the Penedès region.

Espluga del Francolí d Poblet (50 km from our Mas)

In this small town, you will find a beautiful agricultural museum, huge caves, and you can learn how brandy is made in the restored distillery Fassino Balanya. Monday is in Espluga everything closed.

Please note that museums close between 14h00 and 17h00.

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On 2.5 km from L'espluga del Francolí, you will find the beautiful **monastery of Poblet**, the largest inhabited Cistercian Monastery in Europe. In 1991, it was declared World Heritage site by UNESCO. A must do!

Siurana, a 50 minute-drive from the Mas

Siurana is a small fortress with ruins of an ancient castle, spectacularly situated on a high rock. You reach the tiny village via a winding road through the mountains. Once up there you can enjoy breath-taking views of the surrounding hills, the reservoir of Siurana and the Montsant mountain range.



You can combine Siurana very well with the beautiful village of **Prades** and with walks in the Siurana-Prades area.



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Miravet Castle, Carrer del Castell, 7, 43747 Miravet, a 50-minute drive from the Mas.

At the top of the old center of Miravet, you will find this impressive fortress of Arab origins. Built by the Muslims in the 9th century, the castle was one of the last Islamic fortresses in Catalonia. The fortress consists of several parts including the Romanesque chapel. From the castle you have a beautiful view over the meander of the Ebro.

Miravet has a long tradition of making traditional ceramics and currently has 6 active workshops in La Raval dels Canterers. La Raval is a neighborhood on the outskirts of the town where the ceramic tradition is kept alive.

Raval dels Canters is located at the entrance to Miravet on the T-324 road that comes from Móra d'Ebre and Benissanet, the neighborhood is on a small plateau, where it was protected from the floods of the Ebre and near the river from which they extracted the mud.

[Navigating the Ebro River](#) from Miravet is a way to get to know the river and enjoy the landscape, while at the same time understanding how the ancient navigation of the fishermen who circulated the river with all kinds of goods and people used to be.

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Visit the Ebro Delta, at 1 hour drive from the Mas



The Ebro delta, where the Ebro flows into the Mediterranean Sea, is a beautiful nature reserve. The most surprising thing maybe is, that from our region with mountains and olive trees, after a 50-minute drive, you end up in the lowlands, where rice is grown and flamingos and countless other birds' nest in a huge freshwater area. There are beautiful beaches, you can take a boat trip on the river, eat Paella, do bird watching, ride a bicycle, watch flamingos, visit rice field and producers and much more.

Visit to the picturesque village of Horta de Sant Joan in combination with cycling the *Via verde*, an old train track.

Horta de San Joan is one of the most beautiful villages in the province of Tarragona. The surrounding mountains and the medieval alleys of the historic centre, give it an almost magical character. Horta de Joan is at 1 hour drive from the Mas.



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After you visit of the village, you can rent bicycles at Esgambi in Horta de Sant Joan and cycle from there to Benifallet, about 25 kilometres away.

You agree with the bicycle rental company at what time you want to be picked up again in Benifallet.

Only the first 200m of the route is steep, after that everything goes downhill. The bicycle rental company also rents out child seats, trailer bicycles, carts, baskets, tire repair kits and flashlights, in case there is no light in the various railway tunnels you have to pass.

Take your swim suits with you, as there is a small river along the cycle path, where you can swim and cool off.

Smoking

Smoking is prohibited by law in all publicly accessible areas, as in all the interior of our Mas. Please note that all areas in the Mas are fitted with smoke detectors.

Sustainability

When we bought the house, our primary goal was to transform the deteriorated farmhouse into a sustainable and comfortable accommodation with minimal environmental impact. For this reason, we invest a lot of time and effort in the design and construction of several sustainable energy installations and the implementation of various "eco-practices".

We installed:

- a geothermal installation to cool and heat the house. This is a geothermal heat pump that uses the earth as a storage medium to accumulate unwanted heat in summer and extract heat in winter. Geothermal energy is known as one of the most energy effective heating / cooling systems available.
- a waste-water treatment plant, which change wastewater into water to irrigate the olive trees.
- 46,4 KW of photovoltaic panels, reducing our CO2 footprint with 45 tons of CO2 per year.
These 46,4 KW provide for 60% of all our electricity consumption.
- 40m2 of solar panels to heat the pool.
- LED lighting: 95% of the bulbs are LED.
- we planted more than 100 trees to compensate for our CO2 emissions
- all rooms have an A + led television,
- the windows are energy efficient windows and offer better insulation and more efficiency. They have double glazing, which high insulation.
- our washers, dryers and dishwashers are of class A or higher.
- all toilets have a double flush.

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- all wash basins in the rooms have a special faucet that reduces the water consumption with 85%.

We also adapted several "Eco-practices":

- we collect the rainwater and the condensation of the air conditioning in our water reservoir.
- we separate our waste; In your room you find a basket for paper to help us recycling.
- we only change the towels you leave for us on the floor of your bathroom.
- we give all food leftovers to our chicken.
- we preferably use nearby suppliers and local products. For example: honey from our neighbour, eggs from our chicken, vegetables and fruits from our neighbour that has 50hectares of ecological fruits and vegetables, and fruit from our own garden.
- we do not have minibars in the rooms. Instead, you share a refrigerator in the communal kitchen.

In November 2014, TripAdvisor rewarded us, after an exhaustive audit carried out by Canadian and North American technicians, with the "Eco leader" distinction. A great acknowledge as sustainable accommodation. In the province of Tarragona only 5 hotels (!) are rewarded.

In November 2016, Endesa granted us the A +++ energy efficiency classification. And in 2018 we received official recognition of being the best project in sustainability and hotel rehabilitation in all of Spain!
